1. Girl's iron folate tablet supplementation (GIFTS)
2. Micro nutrient powder supplementation (MNP)
3. Nutrition school friendly initiative (NSFI)
4. Vitamin A supplementation
5. Maternal, infant and young child Nutrition. (IYCN)
6. Community-base management of acute malnutrition (CMAM)
7. Iron folic acid supplementation to pregnant women and lactating mothers.
